Welcome to Newsletter No. 8, our first for 2019, a little later than we intended but we have been very, very busy. Whilst Terry just ploughed on through our Christmas “break” by making a start on the final typesetting of the hundreds of West Dapto Cemetery biographies, Wendy was working full-time on another project that has now come to fruition. 30 years ago, in 1989, we published our first family history book, the 500 page *The Black Swan* documenting the 5000+ descendants of Terry's g-g-g-grandfather, Edward Hornsby, alias Swan, who arrived in NSW in March 1819.

In response to pressure from some of Edward's current day descendants, Wendy agreed to mark the 200th anniversary of Edward's arrival by publishing a prequel to our 1989 book. As more English records became available over the years, first on CD and then on the internet, Wendy had gradually worked backwards from Edward, tracing his ancestry back into the 1600's or 1500's on various lines. Thus Wendy's Christmas “break” consisted of finishing off that research and compiling it into a new 109 page book. The new book was successfully launched on March 16th, together with a facsimile reprint of our 1989 publication. After selling all but a handful of the 1200 copies of the 1989 book we still receive requests for more copies so we have had an original copy unbound and scanned to allow the new print run. Add to that effort the task of trying to track down as many of the 1200 owners of *The Black Swan* as possible to see if they would like a copy of the new book, accepting orders and payments there-from, and then getting (so far) about 250 copies of the new book and 40 copies of the old book packaged up ready for pickup or mailing you can see we have been very busy.

So How Big Will The First West Dapto Book Be??

One reason for Terry to continue the West Dapto work straight through the Christmas period was to gain an insight into just how big this first West Dapto publication is going to be. Although some biographies still await a few finishing touches as “loose ends” are noticed, or some biographies even await commencement (eg for Terry's cousin Peter Keys who died this month) virtually all the biographical text has been typeset into its final, two columned format as it will appear in the book. Smooth transition from one column or page to the next has not been attended to at this stage as the content will be adjusted once photos are added and those “loose ends” are tidied up. We are also still working on the introductory chapters and the index can only be finalised once all the other content is in its absolute final form.

So ... the answer to the big question can be given in at least general terms, even at this early stage. At the moment, with the biography formatting done to date and most introductory chapters written, the book files total just on 1200 pages, hence we expect the first publication will be in the form of 3 volumes each being between 400 and 500 pages long. Whilst this will push the purchase price upwards, at least the printer has confirmed that the binding of 3 equally sized hard covered volumes will mean a significant reduction in the binding component of the total cost. Once a person orders beyond 200 hard covered books, the binding price per book starts to tumble, so having three volumes will gain us the maximum discount possible from the binder. We will soon be asking the printer for a budget quote that we can then use as a basis for applications for heritage grant assistance from the relevant bodies.

Pre-Publication Offer

Once we have a firm idea as to the cost of the first publication, we will start looking at issuing a pre-publication offer - a discounted price for those happy to pre-pay for their copy of the publication. Why do we do this? Pre-publication offers are a method whereby (i) the likely market can be judged (and hence how many copies should be ordered from the printer) and (ii) a significant portion of the printing cost can be accumulated in advance and hence minimise the actual outlay by whoever gets to pay the printer's bill. Possible grants will also influence the actual printing cost and hence both the pre-publication discount price and normal selling price – we will let you know more when we can.

Godparents to Whom??

As we have previously indicated, where possible we have included the names of the godparents for each of the people documented in the book, be they one of the 'main' people, ie someone who is buried in the cemetery, or one of the children there-of. What we hadn't looked at previously though, was who each of the main people were also godparents for.

As many of these babies could have belonged to other families who may not have biographies in the book, this inter-family involvement or friendship would have gone unrecorded. Hence, in between working on her other Swan family related project, Wendy has perused our transcripts of the early church registers to try and find as many instances where those with biographies in the book are mentioned as godparents in baptisms we may not have already documented. These 16 pages of such instances will now be sorted and added to the relevant biographies, noting the child's name and, just as importantly, the names of the child's parents. One would expect that those parents must have been close friends with and / or thought highly of the godparents, so through these baptismal links we hope to be able to provide a further guide to the social structure of or interaction within the parish throughout the years.

Of course there will always be a catch, the same catch we encounter when trying to sort out which newspaper reports might relate to individual members of large family groups. For example, the various Larkin families (all stemming from the one ancestor) abound with Patricks, Peters etc etc. Even if one diligently compares baptismal dates with dates of birth (and hence age based eligibility to be a godparent – and often children were godparents from the age of about 10!) or dates of death, one can still be left with multiple possibilities of just which individual "Patrick Larkin" say, a godfather might be, especially if the godmother is not the wife of one of the possible Patrick Larkins. Hence some such instances have just had to be omitted.

Recent Additions to the "Early Families"

She keeps finding them!!! Whilst tidying up some of the loose ends, as well as continuing combing through the remaining 600 or so people to be covered in our second book, Wendy has identified yet a few more that are actually grandchildren of members of Early Families, and hence need to be brought forward into the first book.

The latest instances of these are Noel Davis, who died in December last year, and his wife Enid. Wendy found that Enid was a descendant of the Summers family – her parents are not in the cemetery but her grandfather, John Summers, and great grandfather, Richard Summers, are, the latter being buried in 1896, thus making that family an "Early" Family. Prior to the detailed research on Enid that would have occurred for the second book, this link was stumbled across when typing up the death notices for John Summers' children, which of course included Enid's father, Cecil, with Enid and Noel being mentioned in Cecil's death notice. Noel's Jordan ancestors were not going to be in the first book as the earlier generations were buried elsewhere, but with Noel being included because of Enid, his ancestors should be included also. Hence from something noticed in one death notice, a further 8 or 10 people were moved forward so as to keep the full ancestral lines together.

Land Records Completed At Last

Since completing typesetting the biographies, Terry has been working on creating maps showing the locations of both farms and residential lots located in and around Dapto. For the reader, the first mention of a farm or allotment in a biography is followed by a map reference and a brief description of where the property was located. If the reader feels the description is insufficient, the map reference will allow the reader to find the relevant map in the introductory chapter on land ownership. Each map is preceded by a table listing all properties that appear on the following map, with a summary of the changes in property ownership that are relevant to the biography or biographies in which that property is mentioned. In the table relating to the three large maps covering over 90 rural properties in the West Dapto – Mt Kembla area, the table entry for each property specifies which map the property may be found on, and also the area of the map (eg top left) the property is located in.

PHOTOS PLEASE !!!!!!!!

Please, please, please, before it is too late, if you have photos of any of the following near 600 people who will be documented in the first publication, can you contact us ASAP so we can copy them for inclusion. Once the final typesetting (including photos) progresses alphabetically past each person's biography, there will be no going back for a late inclusion. The re-work would be just too time consuming.

In the following table the presence of a known photograph of a person is indicated by the letter "P" before their name. However, you might have a better photo, or our photo may only be as a member

of a group photo. Hence, if you have any photographs of any of these people, whether they have the letter "P" in front of them or not, we want to hear from you PLEASE.

As you can see, although many of these people either died prior to the advent of portrait photography or died as babies, overall we have precious few photos for the remainder.
