Dear Parents and Carers,

Please find attached the **St John's Parish Sacramental Dates for 2023** - Sacraments of Penance (Reconciliation), Eucharist (First Communion) and Confirmation.

It is very important that parents and carers are very aware of the dates and expectations for each sacramental programme. It is part of your responsibility in preparing your child for a sacrament that priority is given to this. Please understand it will be very difficult to make changes once enrolment dates have passed.

Children must be in Year 3 or above (and have been baptised) to make the **Sacrament of Penance** (Reconciliation) and the Sacrament of First Holy Communion (Eucharist).

Children must be in Year 6 or above (and made their First Communion) to make the **Sacrament of Confirmation**.

Please note, children must have the support of **both** parents in order to enrol for a sacrament.

We look forward to assisting you in this important journey with your child. Please contact Fr Francis or Ms Maguire if you have any questions or concerns.

2023 RECONCILIATION (FIRST PENANCE) & FIRST HOLY COMMUNION (EUCHARIST) SACRAMENTAL DATES

To enrol for the sacraments, your child needs to be a **baptised Catholic** and must have **at least one parent who is Catholic**. If you (the parent) is Catholic and your child has not yet been baptised or has been baptised in another Christian faith but not received into the Catholic Church and you would like them to be, you will need to contact the parish office (Ph: 4261 1315) to make an appointment to see Father Francis. This year we are completing the Sacraments of Reconciliation and First Holy Communion together. Candidates will complete the preparation booklet for Reconciliation in the 3 weekends (beginning 2nd/3rd Sept.) and First Holy Communion in the 3 weekends (beginning 14th/15th Oct.). The Sacrament of Reconciliation will be held as part of the Workshop Day on the 26th of October.

Attendance at the Parent Nighton the 24th of August is a <u>compulsory requirement</u> when enrolling your child for the sacraments. If you are unable to make this night, you will need to contact the parish office <u>(well before the date)</u> so that we can make other arrangements.

On this night, parents bring back the Enrolment Sheet, pay \$30 and present Baptismal Certificate (only if the candidate was baptised in another parish and has not received any other sacraments at St John's). THE PROGRAMME This Reconciliation/First Holy Communion programme begins with the enrolment weekends on the 19th/20th or 26th/27th August. Candidates and their parents/carers are asked to be at Mass every weekend during this time. If you need to be at Mass at a different parish on any of these weekends, please write the name of the parish and get the priest to sign at the back of your book. At the end of mass on the weekends listed, the candidate presents their booklet with the lesson/s completed to one of the parishioners/teachers at the back side door of the church where the completed lessons will be stamped/signed. If you are unable to be at church on a particular weekend, then you will need to contact the parish office to make other arrangements. 2023 CONFIRMATION SACRAMENTAL DATES

To enrol for a sacrament, children need to be a **baptised Catholic** and must have **at least one parent who is Catholic**. If you (the parent) is Catholic and your child has not yet been baptised or has been baptised in another Christian faith but not received into the Catholic Church and you wish them to be, you will need to contact the parish office (Ph: 4261 1315) to make an appointment to see Father Francis. To receive the Sacrament of Confirmation candidates must have already received the Sacrament of Reconciliation and First Holy Communion (Eucharist).

Attendance at the Parent Night for all Sacraments is a <u>compulsory requirement</u> when enrolling your child for a sacrament. If you are unable to make this night, you will need to contact the parish office (well before the date) so that we can make other arrangements.

THE PROGRAMME This Confirmation programme runs for 8 weekends beginning with enrolment. Candidates and their parents/carers are encouraged to come to Mass every weekend during this time. At the end of mass on the weekends listed, the candidate presents their booklet with the lesson/s completed to one of the parishioners/teachers at the back side door of the church where the completed lessons will be stamped/signed. If you are unable to be at church on a particular weekend, then you will need to contact the parish office to make other arrangements. RECONCILIATION It is necessary that all candidates receive the sacrament of Reconciliation in the days/weeks before receiving the Sacrament of Confirmation. St John's Parish School Students will have the opportunity to receive Reconciliation at school just before Confirmation. However, if a child is away from school on this day, they will need to receive Reconciliation on Friday 26th May, along with the children from other schools.	Friday 26th May 5pm
